# Abraham Lincoln

**Abraham Lincoln** was the 16th President of the United States from 1861 to 1865. A strong opponent of slavery, he led the country during the American Civil War.

Shortly before Lincoln's election, southern secessionists left the *Union of States* and formed the Confederate States of America (The Confederacy).

#### The American Civil War

When Lincoln took office **The Confederacy** was already established but he refused to declare war against the South unless the North was attacked first. This finally happened in April 1861.


The American Civil War was the first modern war. New methods of warfare were used, such as mines and rifles, armoured vessels and even submarines. It was also the first war where railroads played a major role.

The Civil War was also a great turning point in history because it led to the **abolition of slavery** in the United States.

#### The House Divided

In 1860 the USA was a divided nation composed of 18 free and 15 slave states. Between the North and the South there were deep economic, social, and political differences.

Slaves were a cheap labour force in the South, while **the North** didn't need them, as most of its



factory workers were

European immigrants. Northerners wanted free public education, rights for women, and better salaries and working conditions, while **the South** felt that these things were not so important.

#### War is over!

On April 9th 1865 General Lee and The Confederacy surrendered and the war was effectively over. Lincoln declared that the Union was ready to "re-unite the Divided House", but was killed in a theatre by a Confederate spy three days later.

This was the first presidential assassination in US history and made Lincoln a martyr to the ideal of national unity.
