**• Word perfect: How to help Secondary students boost their vocabulary**

Vocabulary teaching can often appear relatively simple and straightforward, but unfortunately vocabulary learning by the students can seem frustratingly slow and difficult! In this session we will investigate what it means to really 'know' a word, and what influence this has on how we should recycle and practise vocabulary in the Secondary classroom. We will also explore how memory works and the important implications that this can have for the design of recycling activities that genuinely help students to boost their word power. There will be demonstration of a wide variety of practical classroom activities and strategies, the aims of which are to make vocabulary learning more effective, stimulating and enjoyable for Secondary students.

**• Getting Inside Language: What do our students really need to improve their knowledge of language?**
